SOCIAL JUSTICE & OUTREACH

COMFORT TREE - Social Justice and Outreach will be putting up a " Comfort Tree", in the Narthex for **Sunday Dec. 2nd**. This year, your gifts under the tree will be donated to Haven House, a local agency, which last year provided transition and overnight stays for 435 local women and children fleeing abuse. Please decorate our "Comfort Tree with "Cozy" donations to brighten their lives. They will be appreciated by women in crisis.

WHITE GIFT SUNDAY – This is a special day each year when we share our Christmas with the S.O.S. Christmas Project for families who need some help in providing gifts for their children and teenagers. This is the 50th year that S.O.S. has sponsored this Christmas Program. Here at Knox we have continued the tradition which dates to 1904 in Ohio, when the wife of a Methodist minister and their two daughters came up with the idea of giving gifts wrapped in white, so they would be anonymous. In the interest of saving trees, we do NOT wrap the gifts we bring. THE REDress PROJECT - was initiated by Winnipeg-based artist Jaime Black in 2011 to be an aesthetic response to the issue of missing and murdered Indigenous women across Canada. Red Dresses are on display in various locations in the Oceanside area to mark **November 25**th as the **UN International Day to Eliminate Violence Against Women** and will be on display until December 10 to correspond with the **16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence. December 10** is also **Human Rights Day**.

A MESSAGE TO KNOX - Jada Morgan, who shared her story last week about her call from God to help the children of Lebanon, and her subsequent call to sponsor one of the Syrian families she met while there, is hoping to form a group of 3 -5 people to accomplish this. She wanted folks who might be interested to know that she is willing to take on the burden of the financial responsibility of a group of 5, so please don't let financial fears be the reason for backing away from a Refugee Sponsorship Group. "I'm not asking for people to help me fundraise...I'm looking for a core group of 3-5 people who are willing to help me to settle this family."

What would be required of you?

- Helping the family to locate suitable housing
- Help with Interpretation and learning English
- Help connect family with ESL training/support
- Help to acquire furnishings
- Transportation Help transport the family to buy groceries, shopping, Dr's appointments etc.
- Banking Help family with the process of setting up bank account
- Help with obtaining Driver's license
- Attend a 2-day workshop with the Anglican church on working with a sensitive population and refugee sponsorship
- Sign a contract with the Anglican church committing to the settlement of the family which ends a year after the family arrives
